BEFORE THE MEETING DAY

The checklist of registered voters will be posted by September 15, 2026. Make sure your name is on it. If your name is not on it, you should register to vote.

WHEN: Any time up to and including October 15. Same day voter registration is now available in Vermont.

WHERE: Town Clerk's Office, 1672 VT Route 14, South Woodbury, Monday 8-12, Tuesday 12-6, Wednesday and Thursday 8-12.

Or, ON-LINE: Eligible voters may also register to vote through the Secretary of State's Online Voter Registration System at www.olvt.sec.state.vt.us

AT THE MEETING

If your name was dropped from the checklist in error, or has not been added even though you submitted a timely application for addition to the checklist, you can fill out a new registration form. If the clerk or Board of Civil Authority does not add your name, you can appeal the decision to a superior court judge, who will settle the matter. Call the Secretary of State's Office at 1-800-439-VOTE (439-8683) for more information.

If you are a first-time voter who submitted your application to the checklist individually by mail and did not submit required documentation, you must provide a current and valid photo identification, or a bank statement, utility bill or government document that contains your name and current address.

If you have a physical disability, are visually impaired, or cannot read, you may have assistance from any person of your choice. If you know a voter who has a disability, let them know they may have assistance from any person of their choice. **The meeting place is accessible by elevator.**

The Town of Woodbury does not discriminate based on disability, and is committed to conducting accessible meetings. To request a reasonable accommodation to attend this Town Meeting, please contact the Town Clerk as early as possible before the meeting.
